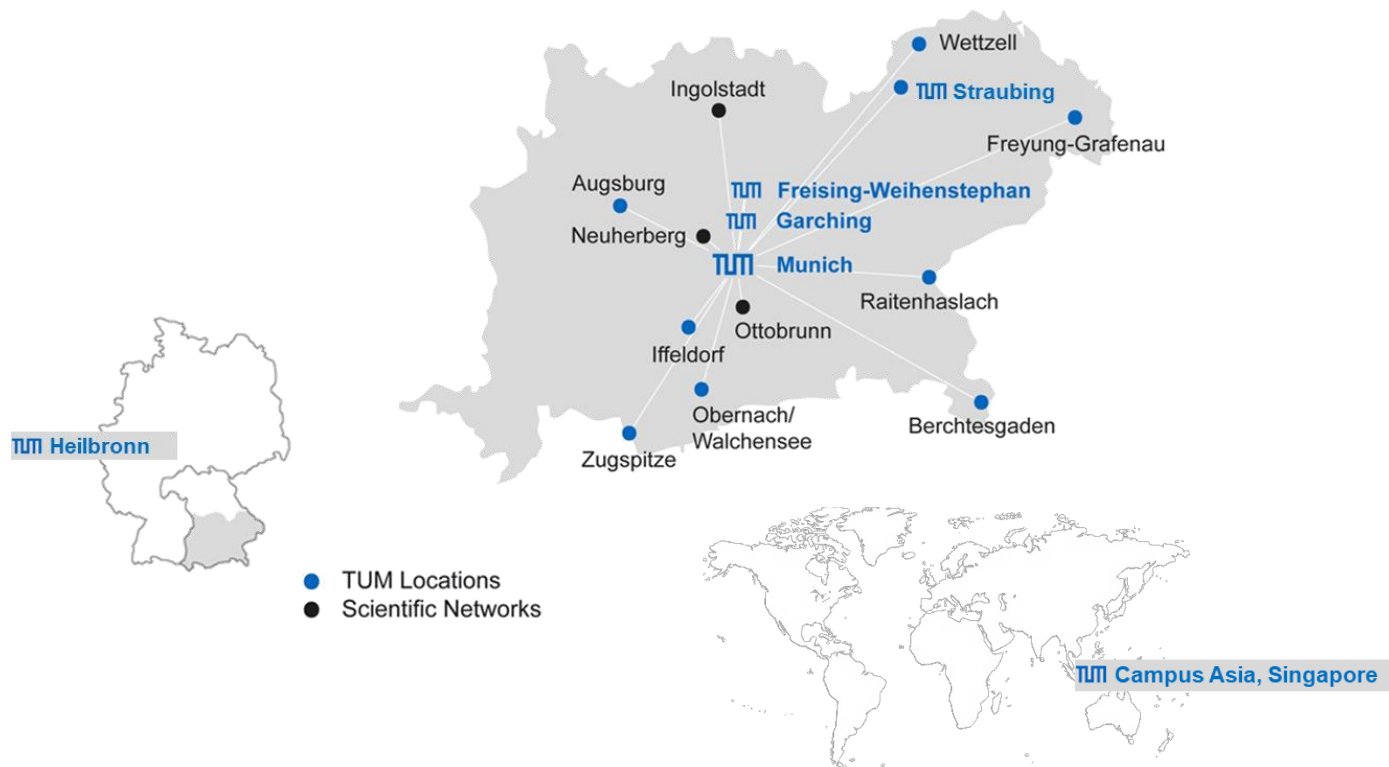


TUM Campus Straubing for Biotechnology and Sustainability

Information for Incoming Exchange Students

Location of TUM Campus Straubing

- Campus Straubing is one of TUM's six campus and the campus furthest North within Bavaria.
- The distance between Campus Straubing and Campus Munich is roughly 130 km.

Language Requirements and Language Certificates

- The minimum level of English or German for incoming exchange student at TUM Campus Straubing is B1 in the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages: Learning, Teaching, Assessment (CEFR). We strongly advise exchange students to at strive to improve their language skills to at least B2 for a successful stay at TUM Campus Straubing (as reference: admission requirements for our English master degree programs is C1).
- The following certificates are accepted (no older than two years at the beginning of your stay):
 - Commercial certificates
 - TOEFL
 - CAE/CPE
 - IELTS
 - Certificates issued by your home university stating the level of your language skills



Courses/Modules

- The courses at TUM Campus Straubing are organized in modules.
- To pass a module you need to pass all mandatory parts (for example written examination, project work, presentation, lab practical). No partial credits are given for submitting only parts of the examination requirements.
- Module handbooks for all degree programs can be found on the program specific pages at www.cs.tum.de under the section "Studies".
- Detailed information about the focus and content of a module as well as exams and admission requirements/recommended knowledge can be found in the module descriptions.
- The language of instruction for each module is also stated in the module descriptions.
- A list of modules offered in the next semester is published on our webpage in March for summer semester and September for winter semester.
- For orientation, you can also check out the module lists from the previous year.
- Modules are usually offered once a year in a regular cycle (either in summer or in winter semesters).

Minimum Credits and Courses at Other Faculties/Schools

- When planning your semester at TUM Campus Straubing you should select courses with a minimum of 20 ECTS credits (for reference: a normal semester workload is 30 ECTS credits)
- Besides modules from TUM Campus Straubing you can also register for courses and modules at other faculties and schools of TUM. If you choose to do so, please keep the following in mind:
 - At least 60% of the ECTS credits on your learning agreement need to be from modules offered by TUM Campus Straubing
 - Courses and modules from other faculties and schools will require commuting to other campuses. Organization of transportation are up to the student.

Registering for Courses

- Once you have been enrolled as an exchange student at TUM (which happens usually around mid-September for winter semester and mid-March for summer semester), you are able to register for courses in TUMonline.
- For most courses registration period starts mid-September, but please check for each of your courses in the modules on your learning agreement individually as registration deadlines may vary.
- Search for the modules on your learning agreement using the module search function in TUMonline.
- In the details of the module description, you will find courses (marked by triangles) and examinations (marked by circles) offered in this module.
 - A green dot indicates registration is possible at this point of time.
 - A grey dot indicates that registration has not yet started.
 - A red dot indicates registration period has expired. In this case, please contact olivia.chia-leeson@tum.de to see if there is a possibility for late registration.
- Make sure you register for all courses in the module (for example lecture, exercise, tutorial, practical...).



- For each course, there are also information available in TUMonline regarding the technicalities of place allocation (for courses with maximum number of participants) and expected date for finalizing the list of participants. This means for some courses you will receive an instant confirmation mail, while for others it may take some time before the available places in a course are allocated.

Exams and Transcript of Records

- Registration for exams will start mid semester, but again, please check individually for each module as deadlines may vary.
- Each exam also has a de-registration period, during which you can withdraw from the exam. After this, you will not be able to drop out from an exam other than due to unforeseeable reasons that are not within your control, such as sickness.
- You can download your transcript of records after your stay from your personal documents section in TUMonline.
